SUNSHINE HEALTH COMMUNITY SOLUTIONS, INC.

CONSENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE came for consideration as a result of the filing of a request to modify its Plan of Operations by SUNSHINE HEALTH COMMUNITY SOLUTIONS, INC. ("SUNSHINE HEALTH") as required in Consent Order Case Number 189334-16-CO paragraph 31 with the FLORIDA OFFICE OF INSURANCE REGULATION ("OFFICE"). Following a complete review of the record, and upon consideration thereof, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the OFFICE hereby finds as follows:

- 1. The OFFICE has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and parties to this proceeding.
- 2. SUNSHINE HEALTH is licensed as a domestic Health Maintenance Organization.
 - 3. Currently, SUNSHINE HEALTH does not have any Florida subscribers.
- 4. On February 7, 2023, SUNSHINE HEALTH provided the OFFICE with an updated business plan ("Plan"). SUNSHINE HEALTH plans to seek licensure in Virginia as a health maintenance organization ("HMO") in order to submit an application to the Centers for

- Medicare & Medicaid Services ("CMS") to offer Medicare Advantage plans statewide in Virginia, in addition to any other future business permitted under a Virginia HMO certificate of authority.
- 5. In order to facilitate the Plan, SUNSHINE HEALTH is seeking the OFFICE's approval of the change to its Plan of Operations.
- 6. After reviewing the material provided by SUNSHINE HEALTH, Florida law and having further discussions with SUNSHINE HEALTH, the OFFICE and SUNSHINE HEALTH agree as follows:
 - a. The OFFICE approves SUNSHINE HEALTH filing an application with CMS as outlined in paragraph 4 above and in the Plan.
 - b. SUNSHINE HEALTH will apply for a certificate of authority in Virginia as an HMO.
 - c. As directed by the Virginia Department of Insurance, SUNSHINE HEALTH will apply to re-domesticate itself as a corporate entity from Florida to Virginia when provisional approval is obtained for the Virginia HMO certificate of authority.
 - d. Once SUNSHINE HEALTH receives its Virginia HMO certificate of authority, it will file to surrender its HMO license in Florida.
- 7. Any prior orders, consent orders, or corrective action plans that SUNSHINE HEALTH has entered into with the OFFICE prior to the execution of this Consent Order shall apply and remain in full force and effect for SUNSHINE HEALTH, except where provisions of such orders, consent orders, or corrective action plans have expired; have been superseded by

subsequent orders, consent orders, or corrective action plans; or are inconsistent with this Consent Order.

- 8. Any deadlines, reporting requirements, other provisions, or requirements set forth in this Consent Order may be altered or terminated by written approval of the OFFICE. Such approval must be requested in writing prior to any proposed deviation from the terms of this Consent Order.
- 9. SUNSHINE HEALTH expressly waives a hearing in this matter, the making of findings of fact and conclusions of law by the OFFICE, and all further and other proceedings herein to which it may be entitled by law or rules of the OFFICE. SUNSHINE HEALTH hereby knowingly and voluntarily waives all rights to challenge or to contest this Consent Order in any forum available to it, now or in the future, including the right to any administrative proceeding, state or federal court action, or any appeal.
 - 10. Each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees.
- 11. SUNSHINE HEALTH agrees that, upon execution of this Consent Order, failure to adhere to one or more of the terms and conditions contained herein may result, without further proceedings, in the OFFICE suspending, revoking, or taking other administrative action as it deems appropriate upon SUNSHINE HEALTH's Certificate of Authority in this state in accordance with Sections 120.569(2)(n) and 120.60(6), Florida Statutes.
- 12. The parties agree that this Consent Order shall be deemed to be executed when the OFFICE has signed and docketed a copy of this Consent Order bearing the notarized signature of the authorized representative of SUNSHINE HEALTH.

WHEREFORE, the agreement as set forth above between SUNSHINE HEALTH COMMUNITY SOLUTIONS, INC., and the FLORIDA OFFICE OF INSURANCE REGULATION, is APPROVED.

FURTHER, all terms and conditions contained herein are hereby ORDERED.
