CONSENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration as the result of an agreement between **FEDERATED NATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY**, hereinafter referred to as **FEDERATED** and the **FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE**, hereinafter referred to as the **DEPARTMENT**.

Following a complete review of the entire record, and upon consideration thereof, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Treasurer and Insurance Commissioner, as head of the **FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE**, hereby finds as follows:

1. The Treasurer and Insurance Commissioner, as head of the **DEPARTMENT**, has jurisdiction over the subject matter of, and parties to, this proceeding.

2. **FEDERATED** is a domestic property and casualty insurer authorized to transact insurance business in Florida and is subject to the jurisdiction and regulation of the **DEPARTMENT** pursuant to the Florida Insurance Code.

3. The **DEPARTMENT** conducted a property and casualty target market conduct examination of **FEDERATED** covering the period of January 1999 through November 2000, pursuant to Section 624.3161, Florida Statutes. As a result of such examination, the **DEPARTMENT** determined that **FEDERATED** committed the following violations of the Florida Insurance Code or Florida Administrative Code as outlined in total in the Fine Worksheet provided with the Report of Examination Findings.

a. Mobile Homeowners

1. Section 627.062, F.S.-Failure to Follow Filed Rate, Rating Schedule or Rating Rule-Incorrect Territory.

b. Agents/MGA

1. Section 626.112, F.S.-Use of Unappointed Agent.

c. Cancellations/Nonrenewals

1. Rule 4-167.001, Failure to Return Premium Timely.
2. Section 624.3161, F.S.-Failure to Correct Violation in Prior Exam Report.

d. Claims

1. Section 626.863, F.S.-Use of Unlicensed Adjuster.
2. Section 624.3161, F.S.-Failure to Correct Violation in Prior Exam Report.
3. Section 627.736, F.S.-Failure to Comply with PIP Benefit Requirements.
4. Section 319.30, F.S.-Failure to Properly Forward Mobile Home Titles to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

5. Section 627.4265, F.S.-Failure to Pay Claim Timely.
6. Rule 4-166.024, Failure to Communicate Timely.

e. Complaints

1. Section 626.9541, F.S.-Failure to Comply with Unfair Trade Practice Requirements.

4. The **DEPARTMENT** and **FEDERATED** expressly waive a hearing in this matter and the making of Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law by the **DEPARTMENT** and all further and other proceedings herein to which the parties may be entitled by law. **FEDERATED** hereby knowingly and voluntarily waives the rights to challenge or to contest this Order, in any forum now available to it, including the right to any administrative proceeding, circuit or federal court action, or any appeal.

5. **FEDERATED** agrees that upon the execution of this Consent Order it shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

(a) **FEDERATED** shall pay an administrative penalty of \$3,750 and administrative costs of \$750 on or before the 30th day after this Consent Order is executed.

(b) **FEDERATED** shall henceforth comply with all of the provisions of the Florida Insurance Code and Florida Administrative Code, and will implement the recommendations contained in this report within 90 days after execution of Consent Order, including any pending refunds.

(c) **FEDERATED** is hereby placed on notice of the requirements of the above referenced sections of law and agrees

that any future violations of these sections by **FEDERATED** may be deemed willful, subjecting **FEDERATED** to appropriate penalties.

6. **FEDERATED** agrees that the failure to adhere to one or more of the above terms and conditions of this Order shall constitute a violation of a lawful order of the **DEPARTMENT**, and shall subject **FEDERATED** to such administrative action as the Treasurer and Insurance Commissioner may deem appropriate.

7. Except as noted above, each party to this action shall bear its own costs and attorney's fees.

8. **THEREFORE**, the agreement between **FEDERATED NATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY** and the **DEPARTMENT**, the terms and conditions of that are set forth above, is approved.

FURTHER, all terms and conditions above are hereby **ORDERED**.
