YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that pursuant to the Florida Insurance Code, including Sections 624.307, 624.317, 624.401, 624.606, 626.901, and 626.909 of the Florida Statutes, the State of Florida, Office of Insurance Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the "OFFICE"), has caused an investigation to be made of the insurance-related activities of Global Bonding, Inc., a/k/a Global Bonding, Robert Joe Hanson, a/k/a Robert Hansen, Jerome Jay Weiland (Licensed Agent #A280205), Hexagon Consolidated Companies of America, Inc., Peoples Mining Co., and Maurice W. Furlong. The Office of Insurance Regulation has information that the aforementioned companies and individuals have transacted surety insurance business, in and from the state of Florida, without holding a certificate of authority as a surety insurer.

Global Bonding, Inc., a/k/a Global Bonding, will hereafter be referred to as, "GLOBAL BONDING".

As a result of its investigation, the OFFICE, finds:

1. Section 120.569(2)(n), Florida Statutes, provides that "if an agency head finds that an immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare requires an immediate final order, it shall recite with particularity the facts underlying such finding in the final order..."

2. This Immediate Final Order is being issued pursuant to Section 120.569(2)(n), Florida Statutes, because the facts as stated herein demonstrate that there is an immediate threat to the public health, safety and welfare, including personal and public monetary losses. Furthermore, the issuance of cease and desist orders by several states against Global Bonding, Inc., a/k/a Global Bonding, and Robert Joe Hanson, a/k/a Robert Hansen, demonstrate a continuing pattern of conduct that must be stopped in order to prevent further harm to the public.

3. Section 624.03, Florida Statutes, states: " 'Insurer' includes every person engaged as indemnitor, surety, or contractor in the business of entering into contracts of insurance or of annuity." The Florida Insurance Code requires sureties in Florida to obtain a certificate of authority from the OFFICE, as set forth in Section 624.401, Florida Statutes.

4. Section 624.606, Florida Statutes, defines surety insurance to include:

(a) **A contract bond, including a bid, payment, or maintenance bond, or a performance bond, which guarantees the execution of a contract other than a contract of indebtedness or other monetary obligation; (Emphasis added).**

(b) An indemnity bond for the benefit of a public body, railroad, or charitable organization or a lost security or utility payment bond;

(c) Becoming surety on, or guaranteeing the performance of, any lawful contract where the bond is guaranteeing the execution of a contract other than a contract of indebtedness or other monetary obligation;

(d) Becoming surety on, or guaranteeing the performance of, bonds and undertakings required or permitted in a judicial proceeding or otherwise allowed by law, including surety bonds accepted by states and municipal authorities in lieu of deposits as security for the performance of insurance contracts.

5. GLOBAL BONDING has not procured a certificate of authority permitting it to act as a surety duly licensed in the state of Florida. GLOBAL BONDING is unlicensed and unauthorized to transact any insurance business in Florida, whether as a surety or in any other capacity. GLOBAL BONDING has never held a license or certificate of authority to transact business as a surety in Florida. GLOBAL BONDING has never been qualified as an eligible surplus lines insurer in Florida, pursuant to Sections 626.913 -626.937, Florida Statutes. See attached Exhibit A.

6. GLOBAL BONDING is a foreign corporation registered with the Florida Department of State and incorporated on or about January 2, 2003, under the laws of the state of Nevada. See attached Exhibit B and Exhibit C.

7. GLOBAL BONDING has listed its principal place of business as 6800 Manhattan Blvd., Suite 303, Ft. Worth, Texas 76120. See attached Exhibit D.

8. ROBERT JOE HANSON a/k/a ROBERT HANSEN, (hereafter referred to as "HANSON") has not procured a certificate of authority permitting it to act as a surety, or individual surety, duly licensed in the state of Florida. HANSON is unlicensed and unauthorized to transact any insurance business in Florida, whether as a surety, or individual surety or in any other capacity. HANSON has never held a license or certificate of authority to transact business as a surety, or individual surety in Florida. HANSON has never been qualified as an eligible surplus lines insurer in Florida, pursuant to Sections 626.913 -626.937, Florida Statutes. See attached Exhibit A.

9. HANSON is listed as the president, secretary, and treasurer of GLOBAL BONDING, in the records of the Nevada Secretary of State's corporate information. See attached Exhibit C.

10. HANSON is listed as the chairman, president, secretary, and treasurer of GLOBAL BONDING, in its application to register as a foreign corporation with the State of Florida. HANSON signed the application under the name "Robert Hansen" as chairman of GLOBAL BONDING, located at 6800 Manhattan Blvd., Suite 303, Ft. Worth, Texas 76120. See attached Exhibit D.

11. GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON are soliciting Florida consumers for the purchase of contractor surety bonds and issuing construction performance and bid bonds in the State of Florida. GLOBAL BONDING uses its website at, <http://www.globalbonding.net> to solicit its Florida surety business. See attached Exhibit E.

12. On or about June 24, 2003, GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON offered for sale and sold to Megan South, Inc., a contractor located in Winter Haven, Florida, two contract bonds to insure and protect the obligee, the Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter "FDOT"), for a construction job in Polk County. The two bonds were in excess of twenty-six million dollars (\$26,000,000.00). GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON sold these bonds in violation of the Florida Insurance Code including, Sections 624.401 and 626.901, Florida Statutes. See attached Exhibit F and Exhibit G.

13. Jerome Jay Weiland, a licensed Florida general lines agent, #A280205, countersigned on the two contract bonds issued by GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON to Megan South, Inc., in violation of Section 626.901, Florida Statutes, aiding an unauthorized insurer to solicit or engage in insurance business. See attached Exhibit F and Exhibit G.

14. GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON also issued two bid protest bonds to Megan South, Inc., with the FDOT as the obligee, in violation of the Florida Insurance Code including, Sections 624.401 and 626.901, Florida Statutes. GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON

represented on these bonds that they were duly authorized to do business in Florida as a surety. See attached **Exhibit H** and **Exhibit I**.

15. Hexagon Consolidated Companies of America, Inc. (hereinafter "HCCA"), and its subsidiary, PEEPLES MINING CO., have provided a "Precious Metal Certified Corporate Debenture" certificate claiming to pledge and back GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON for the bid protest bonds issued to Megan South, Inc. MAURICE W. FURLONG, signed the corporate debenture as Chairman, CEO, and President of HCCA. By guaranteeing the obligations of GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON, HCCA and MAURICE W. FURLONG are engaging in the business of surety insurance within the meaning of Section 624.606, Florida Statutes. See attached **Exhibit H** and **Exhibit I**.

16. HCCA, and PEEPLES MINING CO., have not procured a certificate of authority permitting them to act as a surety in the state of Florida, (see **Exhibit A**) in violation of the Florida Insurance Code including, Sections 624.401 and 626.901, Florida Statutes. HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG have aided an unauthorized insurer to solicit or engage in insurance business in violation of Section 626.901, Florida Statutes.

17. On or about October 9, 2003, GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON offered for sale and sold to IPGNETWORK, INC., a contractor located in Opalocka, Florida, a contract bond to insure and protect the obligee, the FDOT, for a construction job in various Florida counties. The bond was in the amount of \$82,535. GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON sold this bond in violation of the Florida Insurance Code including, Sections 624.401 and 626.901, Florida Statutes. See attached **Exhibit J**.

18. On or about October 9, 2003, GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON offered for sale and sold to Complete Highway Improvement, Inc., a contractor located in Sunrise, Florida, a

contract bond to insure and protect the obligee, the FDOT, for a construction job in various Florida counties. The bond was in the amount of \$144,950. GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON sold this bond in violation of the Florida Insurance Code including, Sections 624.401 and 626.901, Florida Statutes. See attached Exhibit K.

19. On or about December 3, 2003, the Office of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Nevada issued an Order to Cease and Desist against GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, and others. The Cease and Desist Order stated that GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON have transacted surety insurance business, in and from the state of Nevada, without holding a certificate of authority as a surety insurer. See attached Exhibit L.

20. On or about December 9, 2003, the Office of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Georgia issued an Order to Cease and Desist against GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, and others. The Cease and Desist Order stated that GLOBAL BONDING and HANSON have transacted the unauthorized business of insurance in Georgia by issuing one or more construction performance bonds in Georgia. See attached Exhibit M.

21. Despite the absence of any certificate of authority or any other authorization to transact insurance business in Florida or act as an insurer pursuant to Section 624.401, Florida Statutes, GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND (Licensed Agent #A280205), HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG have engaged and currently engage in the unlicensed, unauthorized, and therefore, illegal business of insurance covering subjects of insurance located or expressly to be performed in this state at the time of issuance, in violation of the Florida Insurance Code including, Sections 624.401 and 626.901, Florida Statutes.

22. GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND (Licensed Agent #A280205), HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG have engaged in the business of insurance in Florida without the benefit of legal authority to do so, thereby creating immediate danger, and/or causing or reasonably expecting to cause significant, imminent, and irreparable injury, to the public.

23. None of the Respondents, entities or persons named in this Immediate Final Order are subject to any exception State or Federal, to the requirements of the Florida Insurance Code, including exceptions outlined in Section 624.402 of the Florida Statutes, nor the Surplus Lines Law, Sections 626.913 - 626.937, Florida Statutes.

24. The issuance and enforcement of this Order is necessary to protect the public and the only way to avoid future harm. If this Immediate Final Order is not entered, the Respondents will continue to conduct their unlicensed and illegal surety insurance business with Florida consumers and jeopardize and delay construction projects planned by our state, municipal and local governments and others.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to the Florida Insurance Code and other applicable statutes, including, Section 120.569(2)(n), Florida Statutes, the OFFICE finds that the continued transaction of insurance without licensure by GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND (Licensed Agent #A280205), HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG, constitute an immediate danger to the public welfare so as to require the issuance of this Immediate Final Order.

**Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

A. GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG, whether acting in the State of Florida as an insurer, surety, or

otherwise engaging in the business of insurance, either directly or indirectly through named and unnamed persons, entities, agents, or otherwise, shall forthwith **CEASE AND DESIST** from the transaction of any surety business with Florida consumers, including individuals, businesses, and state or local government agencies.

JEROME JAY WEILAND (Licensed Agent #A280205) shall forthwith **CEASE AND DESIST** from aiding and assisting in any way, the surety business of GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG.

B. GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG shall forthwith notify, within five (5) days, in writing, each and every principal and obligee on bonds written, sold, or issued to Florida consumers, of the cessation of their Florida insurance business and activities, because they are unlicensed, and shall also inform such persons and entities that no further applications will be accepted nor contracts issued. All parties subject to this Order shall within fifteen (15) days of this Order, file with the OFFICE, the sworn attestations of each officer, director, general partner, member, and limited partner that there has been full compliance with this provision, along with a copy (paper or on computer disk) of all notices mailed.

C. GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG shall, within fifteen (15) calendar days from the date hereof, deliver to the OFFICE a full and complete accounting of all premiums collected, the amount of the bonds, and a copy of each bond, since the inception of its operation in Florida; and a list of all persons or entities used to solicit the business in Florida.

D. Subject to the other mandates of this Immediate Final Order, GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and

MAURICE W. FURLONG shall continue to be responsible for the defense and payment of claims, and otherwise for the timely fulfillment of its contractual obligations to each person or entity insured until all Florida claims have been paid or until further action or order of the OFFICE to the contrary.

E. The entry of this Immediate Final Order, or any amendment thereto, shall not be interpreted as having, nor shall it have, the effect of abrogating any statutory, common law, or contractual rights of any person or entity insured by or who or which may be a third-party beneficiary of, coverage under any policy, contract, or certificate of coverage, nor of any person or entity that has relied upon the existence of a policy, contract, or certificate of coverage with GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG, in granting or allowing any right, privilege, or chose in action.

F. The issuance of this Immediate Final Order and the procedural safeguards set forth herein are concluded to be fair under the circumstances due to the potential grave harm resulting from unauthorized insurance entities engaging in the business of insurance in Florida. As indicated in the Notice of Rights herein, GLOBAL BONDING, HANSON, JEROME JAY WEILAND, HCCA, PEEPLES MINING CO., and MAURICE W. FURLONG are afforded the opportunity to appeal this Order or to enjoin this Order pursuant to Section 120.569 (2)(n), Florida Statutes.



IMMEDIATE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

The Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Georgia (hereinafter the 'Commissioner'), has caused an investigation to be made into the acts, practices, transactions, and course of business engaged in by GLOBAL BONDING (f/k/a 'Millennium Bonding Enterprises') (hereinafter 'GLOBAL'), MILLENNIUM BONDING ENTERPRISES (hereinafter 'MILLENNIUM'), REVE' M. PETE (hereinafter 'PETE'), ROBERT JOE HANSON (hereinafter 'HANSON'), and any persons or entities acting on their behalf or with their authority (all hereinafter collectively referred to as 'Respondents'). Based on that investigation, the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law appear warranted:


FINDINGS OF FACT

1.

Respondents currently transact, or have previously transacted, the unauthorized business of insurance in the State of Georgia as, or on behalf of, unlicensed, unauthorized insurers or agents by issuing one or more construction performance bonds in the State of Georgia.

2.

Insurance guaranteeing the performance of contracts on construction projects falls within the definition of surety insurance in the State of Georgia pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 33-7-7(2), and is thus brought within the scope of the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commissioner under Title 33.

3.

HANSON is, and at all times material hereto was, the President of GLOBAL and MILLENNIUM and has or had offices and a place of business located at 6402 McLeod Boulevard, Suite 5, Las Vegas, Nevada 89120 and in the State of Texas.

4.

GLOBAL formerly operated and conducted business as or in the name of MILLENNIUM, and presently has offices and a principal place of business located at 6402 McLeod Boulevard, Suite 5, Las Vegas, Nevada 89120.

5.

PETE is the registrant of internet addresses which advertise and offer for sale to the consuming public surety bonds, and payment, and performance bonds through GLOBAL. PETE's stated mailing address as registrant is Post Office Box 71263, Albany, Georgia 31708-1263.

6.

On or about July 24, 2002, HANSON offered for sale and sold to Pat Mathis Construction Company Inc., a performance surety bond for a construction project for which Pat Mathis Construction Company Inc., was the general contractor.

7.

On or about July 24, 2002, HANSON thereafter issued (as Attorney in Fact for MILLENNIUM) to Augusta Neighborhood Improvement Corporation, a performance surety bond in the principal sum of \$1,495,000.00, guaranteeing the performance of Pat Mathis Construction Company, Inc., on a construction project contract to be performed in Augusta, Georgia.

Upon information and belief, Respondents have engaged in additional transactions of the unauthorized business of insurance by negotiating and/or issuing performance surety bonds for construction projects at various locations throughout the State of Georgia, including work to be performed in Atlanta, Georgia.

9.

HANSON and PETE are not currently licensed or authorized, nor have HANSON or PETE ever been licensed or authorized to transact the business of insurance in the State of Georgia.

10.

MILLENIUM and GLOBAL are not, and have never been, authorized to transact the business of insurance in the State of Georgia including the issuance of performance bonds, surety bonds or any type of insurance guaranteeing the performance of contracts.

11.

On or about December 3, 2003, the Nevada Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance, acting by and through Alice A. Molasky-Arman, Commissioner, found that Respondents GLOBAL, MILLENNIUM, HANSON and PETE transacted surety insurance business in and from the State of Nevada without holding a certificate of authority as a surety insurer and issued a Cease and Desist Order against GLOBAL, MILLENNIUM, HANSON and PETE to cease and desist all unauthorized insurance activities in the State of Nevada.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1.

The Findings of Fact set forth above show that Respondents have engaged in the solicitation, negotiation, or making of a contract of insurance guaranteeing the performance of a contract related to construction in the State of Georgia as defined by O.C.G.A. § 33-7-7.

The Findings of Fact set forth above show that Respondents have violated basic tenets of public policy by selling, offering or advertising for sale unauthorized insurance and otherwise transacting insurance in the State of Georgia without the required certificates of authority or licenses in violation of O.C.G.A. §§ 33-3-2, 33-5-1, 33-5-22 and 33-23-4. Such actions give reasonable cause to believe that the probability of such continued violations constitute a situation of imminent peril to the public health, safety, or welfare, and that the situation, therefore, requires emergency action.

**ORDER**

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 33-2-24 (c), and by the authority vested in me as the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Georgia, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondents HANSON and PETE, acting directly, by or through any corporation or other entity owned, managed or controlled, in whole or in part, by them, and Respondents GLOBE and MILLENNIUM and any past, present and future parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, predecessors, successors and assigns, and any of their respective past, present and future officers, directors, employees, general agents, agents, brokers, solicitors, representatives, administrators, executors, insurers, predecessors, successors and assigns shall **IMMEDIATELY CEASE and DESIST** from acting as an unauthorized insurer, acting as an agent on behalf of an unauthorized insurer, from the marketing or selling of unauthorized insurance products, charging, billing for, or collecting of any premium or fee related to any unauthorized insurance, or otherwise transacting the unauthorized business of insurance in the State of Georgia, and the Commissioner **FURTHER ORDERS** Respondents to **IMMEDIATELY REMOVE** any reference to GLOBAL or MILLENNIUM from the contents of any web site over which they are the named registrants or over which they have control or influence, specifically including, but not limited to,
