RULE 690-170.003, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, CALCULATION OF INVESTMENT INCOME
2004 PROFIT AND CONTINGENCY FACTORS

Pursuant to Rule 690-170.003, Florida Administrative Code, the Department of Financial Services, Office of Insurance Regulation, annually establishes underwriting profit and contingency factors that may be used in rate filings. Insurers may use the profit and contingency factors referenced below when they are unable to produce credible profit and contingency factors from their own data.
