**All Insurers Authorized to Write Private Passenger Automobile Insurance
in the State of Florida
(Excess Profits)**

The Office of Insurance Regulation (hereinafter referred to as "Office") has determined that some insurers may not be in compliance with the filing requirements of Sections 627.066 and 627.915(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 69O-175.021, Florida Administrative Code.

Section 627.066, Florida Statutes, requires each Florida private passenger automobile insurer group to file with the Office, prior to July 1st of each year, data for Florida private passenger automobile business. The data filed for the group shall be a consolidation of the data of the individual insurers of the group and shall include both voluntary and joint underwriting association business. The required form, OIR-B1-307, and instructions are available from the OIR website at:

Insurers who are not in compliance with the aforementioned statutes and rule should act immediately to meet those requirements. Failure to do so will result in administrative action by the Office.
