To All Property and Casualty Insurers in the State of Florida

Continued Hurricane Reporting

Many areas of Florida have recently been adversely affected by Hurricane Charley, Hurricane Frances, Hurricane Ivan, and Hurricane Jeanne. All property and casualty insurers transacting business in Florida are required to submit to the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation ("Office") information for any property claims that result from Hurricanes Charley, Frances, Ivan, and Jeanne. Pursuant to Informational Memoranda OIR-04-008M, OIR-04-010M, and OIR-04-011M, companies are submitting certain required information for Hurricanes Charley, Frances, and Ivan, respectively. Companies shall continue to update this information and are now required to submit separately information for Hurricane Jeanne. The required information is listed below:

Claims Information for areas in which claims have occurred

Number of Claims Reported to Date, by County;
Number of Claims Determined to be a Total Loss, by County;
Total Claim Payments to Date, by County;
Estimated Case Reserves, by County.

Financial Projections

Best Estimate of Expected Gross Loss resulting from each hurricane;
Projected Net Retention resulting from each hurricane;
Identification of the Model used in calculating the above;
*Estimated Total Dollar Amount of Deductibles for All Residential Claims Reported to Date for each hurricane.

General Information

Location, contact information and hours of operation for any mobile response units that are currently assisting with each hurricane;
Number of adjusters assigned to areas adversely impacted by each hurricane;
Contact Information for the individual submitting the information.

*The deductible should be for residential property claims only. Do not include deductibles for auto physical damage claims or commercial property claims. This applies to the reporting for all disasters.

The information shall be submitted via the Office website at <https://apps.fldfs.com/disasterreporting>. Each insurer shall continue to provide this information to the Office not later than 5:00 pm every Wednesday, until it receives notice from the Office that it is no longer required to do so. Each submission shall contain the cumulative results experienced by the insurer from Hurricane Charley, Hurricane Frances, and Hurricane Ivan, and not information for only the previous week. **Information for Hurricane Charley, Hurricane Frances, Hurricane Ivan, and Hurricane Jeanne should not be combined and must be reported separately.** If there are no changes from the prior submission, then indicate so for the specific items. Please have the Florida Company Code for your company/companies when accessing the system.
