Dear Mr. Dawson,

The Office of Insurance Regulation (“Office”) is in receipt of the Company’s request to defer funding for short-tail liabilities relating to Hurricanes Harvey and Irma for a period of one year from September 30, 2017. The deferral of collateral funding frees up the cash of the Company so that the Company will be able to pay insurance companies in a timely manner, which allows the insurance companies to pay policyholder claims in a timely manner.

Pursuant to Rule 69O-144.007(4), F.A.C., the Office hereby approves the Company’s request to defer any collateral required to be posted from the date of first instance of a liability reserve entry for short-tailed line of business liabilities related to Hurricanes Harvey and Irma for one year.
